EDITORIAL GUIDELINES FOR THE POST-CONFERENCE PUBLICATION

- Size of the article:** maximum 14 pages (with annex, photos, charts)
- Words processor:** MS Word
- File type:** *.doc; *.docx;
- Page size:** B5 (18,2x25,7)
- Page layout:** margins 2,5 cm (all)
- Hyphenation:** no
- Abstract:** in Polish and English
- Key words:** in Polish and English (maximum 6)
- Footnotes:** Harvard style:
- [Sobczak 2006: 10];
 - referring to several works by the same author published in one year, to distinguish them, a lowercase letter is added after the publication date "a", "b" etc., i.e. [Sobczak 2007a: 24] and [Sobczak 2007b: 20];
 - when a publication has up to three authors [Ziółkowski, Kowalski and Nowak 1996: 34],
 - when there are more than three authors, the name of the first one should be given, with abbreviation "et al." (and others), i.e. [Ziółkowski et al. 1997: 89];
 - documents with no author: [UN 2020]; [Ministry of Finance 2021: 10];
 - website: [Europa.eu]; [Europa.eu: a]
